ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 36

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPROVE A NEW SPECIAL EVENT APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF KENT PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE KENT TORCH FEST TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY, JUNE 20, 2019, AND THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WEST MAIN STREET FROM RIVER TO WATER STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Kent Torch Fest is an event to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Cuyahoga River fire that occurred on June 22, 1969; and

WHEREAS, the organizers would like to temporarily close West Main Street from River to Water Street beginning at 10 a.m. on Thursday, June 20th and continue until 10 p.m. that evening;

WHEREAS, the Kent City Council consents to authorizing the City Manager or his designee to sign the Special Event Application as long as he is comfortable and believes the safety and security of the City's citizens will not be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, the time is of the essence as the event is scheduled for June 20, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the Kent City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute the Special Event Application from the Kent Parks and Recreation Department in substantial conformance with the Special Event Application attached hereto as Exhibit "A", as long as the City Manager or his designee believes the safety and security of Kent's citizens are adequately projected.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.




