

# <u>Unauthorized Items</u>

### 1. Authorization to Establish New Ohio Opioid Budget Fund (2022-093)



Rhonda has requested Council's approval to create a new budgetary fund that is required by the State Auditor's Office for the appropriate tracking and management of the Opioid Settlement funds. The City is eligible for Opioid Settlement funds up to \$103,000 over the course of the multi-year payout plan. (attachment)

#### Administration Recommendation

In order to receive the Opioid Settlement funds, the State Auditor's Office requires a designated budget fund to be created. I recommend Council's support to create the new Opioid budget fund.

#### Council Action

Authorize the creation of the new Opioid Settlement budget fund, with the Emergency Clause.

# ABORTION LAW re

2. Authorization of Abortion Law Resolution (2022-094)

At Council's direction, the staff have prepared a draft resolution in opposition to the recent overturning of Roe vs. Wade and the Ohio legislation restricting a woman's autonomy over her reproduction choices. (attachment)

#### Administration Recommendation

Review the draft resolution and direct staff accordingly.

#### Council Action

Consider authorization of the draft resolution opposing the recent changes in national and state reproductive choices.

# Information Items

## 1. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Myers has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for May 2022. In 2022 YTD calls for fire service are up 50.5% (193 calls) for May compared with YTD 2021; fire mutual aid assistance is up by 3 calls (to 8) in 2022 as compared to 2021; and EMS responses are down 9% (134 calls) for May, compared to YTD 2021. (attachment)

### 2. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Myers has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for June 2022. In 2022 YTD calls for fire service are up 43.5% (214 calls) for June compared with YTD 2021; fire mutual aid assistance is up by 4 calls (to 12) in 2022 as compared to 2021; and EMS responses are up 6.9% (121 calls) for June, compared to YTD 2021.
