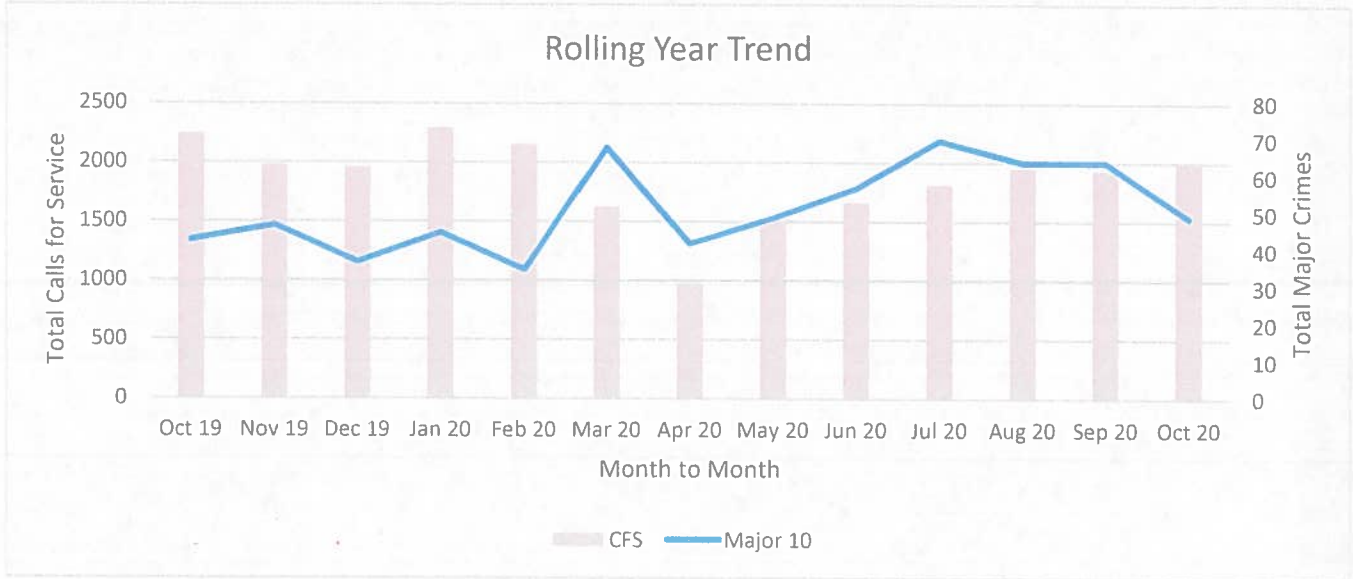

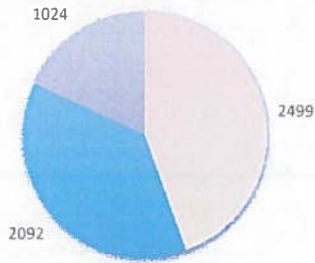

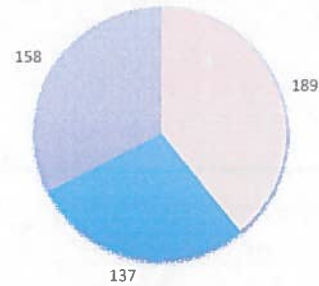
Shift Activity and Action



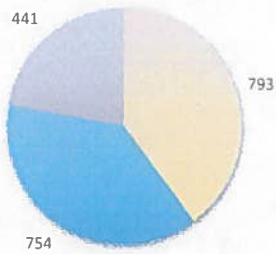
Inbound Calls by Shift



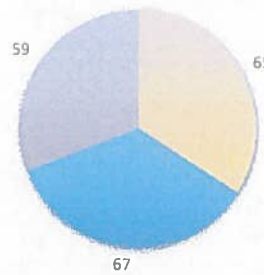
Traffic Stop by Shift



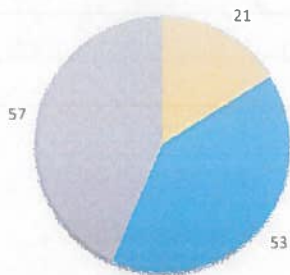
Incidents by Shift



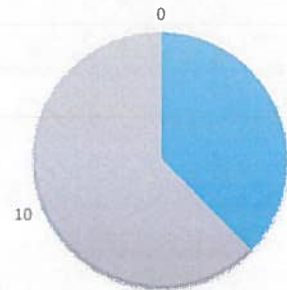
Tickets by Shift



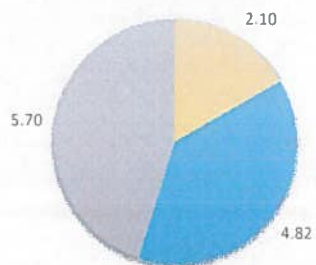

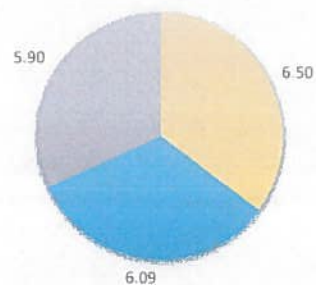
