ORDINANCE 2019 - 102

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT GIVING CONSENT TO THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THEIR BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES FOR THE YEARS 2020-2022; PID 109334; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent has determined the need for the described project:

Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to routine inspections, element level inspections, critical-findings reports, fracture critical member inspections, load rating calculations and reports, weight limits posting sign recommendations, scour assessments, scour plan of actions, development of fracture critical plans, and underwater dive inspection reports if needed.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency (LPA), wishes to give consent to the Director of Transportation for participation in their Bridge Inspection Program Services; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit "A"); and

WHEREAS, the LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence, requiring passage of this Ordinance on an emergency basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into an agreement giving consent to the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for participation in their Bridge Inspection Program services for the years 2020-2022, PID No. 109334; said consent attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to expedite the highway project and to promote highway safety for the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
