

LETTER OF DETERMINATION

Fair Housing Advocates Association v. City of Kent AKR H3 (32911) 10292007

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS:

On October 29, 2007, Complainant, Fair Housing Advocates Association, filed an affidavit with the Ohio Civil Rights Commission alleging that Respondent, City of Kent, engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice. Specifically, Complainant alleged that Respondent's ordinance has a disparate impact on families.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Evidence supports that Respondent's occupancy standard, set forth in "The Environmental Health and Housing Maintenance Code of the City of Kent", states that "[e]very dwelling unit shall contain at least 150 square feet of floor space for the first occupant thereof, and at least 100 additional square feet of floor space for every additional occupant thereof. The floor space [is] to be calculated on the basis of net floor area."

Evidence supports that the ordinance at issue is a reasonable local restriction regarding the maximum number of occupants permitted to occupy a dwelling.

Evidence indicates that the occupancy standard applies to all residents equally including households both with and without children.

Evidence indicates the ordinance was implemented to prevent the overcrowding of units and was adopted from United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare standard occupancy guidelines.

Evidence supports that Respondent used a viable option for determining an appropriate standard, i.e., a minimum number of square feet per person standard.

Evidence supports that Respondent's standard is equivalent to, or more permissive than, standards that have survived a similar legal challenge brought by Charging Party previously.

Based upon its investigation, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission finds that the information gathered during the investigation and supplied by Charging Party does not raise an inference that familial status was the likely motivation for the implementation of Respondent's occupancy ordinance nor that there is a disparate impact on families caused by this reasonable occupancy standard.

Based upon its investigation, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission finds that information does not raise an inference that familial status was the likely motivation for the implementation of Respondent's occupancy ordinance.

DECISION:

Based on the investigation conducted in this matter, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission has determined that there is **No Probable Cause** to believe that the Respondent engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice under section 4112 of the Ohio Revised Code and hereby orders that this matter be **DISMISSED**.

Notwithstanding this dismissal by The Ohio Civil Rights Commission, Title VIII of the Fair Housing Act of 1968 as amended, provides that the Complainant may file a civil action in an appropriate federal district court or state court within two years after the occurrence or termination of the alleged discriminatory housing practice.

The computation of this two-year period does not include the time during which this administrative proceeding was pending. In addition, upon the application of either party to such civil action, the court may appoint an attorney, or may authorize the commencement of or continuation of the civil action without the payment of fees, costs, or security, if the court determines that such party is financially unable to bear the costs of the lawsuit.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO OBTAIN JUDICIAL REVIEW

This determination of the Ohio Civil Rights Commission constitutes a Final Order and is subject to judicial review. The right to obtain judicial review of this order and the mode and procedure thereof is set forth in R.C. 4112.06. A petition for judicial review must be filed within thirty (30) days of mailing of this order. For further information on the process of obtaining judicial review, you are advised to consult an attorney.

The Commission's <u>Rules</u> do not permit any employee of the Commission to grant any extension to this ten-day filing period.

Fire Hydrant Flushing

Why Flush Fire Hydrants?

The city flushes fire hydrants to clean out iron deposits in the water lines, to verify the hydrants are working properly, and to assure continued high quality drinking water. Fire hydrant flushing also provides the Fire and Water Departments with valuable information about water volume and fire flow.



What Takes Place During Fire Hydrant Flushing?

During the testing process, a city operator opens each hydrant to its maximum flow. The flow stirs up iron deposits and settlements and removes them from the system. The operator cleans and lubricates accessible operating parts, checks the operation of the hydrant and valve, and records any deficiencies for repair.

How Often Are Hydrants Flushed?

The city flushes the entire system once a year, generally beginning in June. Before testing, fire hydrant flushing schedules are published in the Record Courier Newspaper and on the city's web page. Businesses that may be adversely affected by the testing, such as doctor's offices, restaurants, and hair salons, receive the schedule by mail or in person.

Will Hydrant Flushing Affect Your Water?

During the flushing process, you may experience some water discoloration, especially when work is being done in your immediate neighborhood. Once the hydrant flushing is complete, the water quality will return to normal.

What Precautions Should You Take?

Before doing laundry or other projects that may suffer from discolored water, make sure the water is running clear. It's also a good idea to keep a pitcher of clean water in the refrigerator.

What If I Still Get Rust Stains?

Call the City Maintenance Division at (330) 673-1688 and they can provide a chemical agent that can help wash out the rust.

2008 Fire Hydrant Flushing



On June 2 2008 the City of Kent Central Maintenance Division will begin the annual fire hydrant flushing program. Crews will be flushing Tuesdays through Fridays, from 2:00 AM to 7:00 AM. Lasting approximately four weeks.

This year the Central Maintenance crews will conduct flow tests on the entire system during the flushing program.

To inform the public of the flushing to be conducted, signs will be placed strategically on main arteries leading into the City. This will include State Route 59 (east and west) and State Route 43 (north and south). Signs also are to be placed at Lake Street, Sunnybrook Road, Mogadore Road, Middlebury Road, State Route 261, Monroe Falls-Kent Road, Fairchild Avenue, and Hudson Drive. These signs will inform people that the flushing is going to take place and the dates the program will run. In addition, smaller A-frame signs will be set out in strategic spots in each section to be flushed the day before crews begin that area.

Press releases will need to be placed in the local newspaper the Friday before the scheduled week of flushing. Personal notification will be made to select businesses, and homes, depending on the importance of their water use. Attached is a list of the locations slated for personal notification, and a copy of the notice.

Also attached is the description of each section and the dates they are scheduled for flushing. These dates are subject to change as the flow testing being conducted takes longer to finish the flushing of the system.
