1. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Tosko has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for May 2020. In 2020 calls for fire service are up 1.7% (7 calls); fire mutual aid assistance is up 2 events as compared to 2019; and EMS responses are down 15.5% (235 calls). (attachment)
