I am requesting City Council's authorization to apply for, and accept if awarded, a 2020 fiscal year Assistance to Firefighters Grant through FEMA for the replacement of the fire department's Self Contained Breathing Apparatus. This program will replace and update the departments SCBAs and related equipment.

The grant is expected not to exceed \$265,000. The City's responsible portion (local matching cost) will be ten percent. The entire amount of \$265,000 has been budgeted through the City Capital Plan already in the event the grant is denied. It is anticipated that no other funds will be required other than the ten percent.
