







Unauthorized Items

1. Appointments

Council will be voting for an appointee to the Sidewalk Snow Removal Committee (Draft numbers 08-219).

2. Union Agreement Extensions

The staff is requesting Council authorization to extend the collective bargaining agreements for the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA), American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) and for the City's General Compensation Plan for unclassified employees from 10/31/08 (current expiration) to 2/28/09, or an additional sixty days beyond 2/28/09, at the City Mgr's discretion. (Draft No. 08-209, 08-210, 08-217)

Administration Recommendation

The staff and the union representatives have recommended making the contract extensions as noted and I also recommend Council's approval.

Council Action

3. Portage County Public Defender Contract

The Law Director has requested Council's authorization to renew the City's contract with Portage County to provide legal counsel to indigent persons in the City of Kent for the period January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009 at a cost of \$80 per case. (Draft No. 08-212)

4. Transfer of Property Taxes From the County

Adopt the resolution authorizing the transfer of tax proceeds.


