## **ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 122**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF KENT TO SUBMIT A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET ASIDE FUNDING APPLICATION (TASA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$483,100 AND EXECUTE THE SUBSEQUENT AGREEMENT WITH AMATS TO DESIGN AND ACQUIRE RIGHT OF WAY FOR THE FINAL SEGMENT OF THE PORTAGE HIKE AND BIKE TRAIL, AND TO ACCEPT THE GRANT, IF AWARDED, WITH CORRESPONDING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the funding application submitted to the Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TASA) will be for the planning, design and engineering work for the final phase of the Portage Hike & Bike Trail between Main Street and Stow Street and is requesting \$483,100; and

WHEREAS, the cost is estimated at \$3,727,198 and we are requesting \$483,100 from TASA. The program will pay 80% of all eligible costs up to \$483,100 and is being requested in fiscal year 2022 with anticipated construction in 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, that:

Kent City Council approves submission of the City's pre-application request for SECTION 1. Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TASA) grant funding totaling \$483,100 and authorized that the Administration provide all information, funds, and documentation required in said applications for submission.

That the Kent City Council hereby approves the City's acceptance of the grant, if awarded SECTION 2. to the City, with corresponding appropriations for its use.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and **SECTION 3.** relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the **SECTION 4.** immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this ordinance is hereby declared₁to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage
