April was a busy month with the groundbreaking for the Multimodal Transit Center, the dedication of the Sculpture Walk at KSU, participation in the Chamber's Community Expo, downtown parking meetings and visits to businesses. In addition, New Day Cleveland, a morning talk show, visited downtown Kent and produced a one hour special highlighting downtown Kent. May was highlighted by the hiring of a part-time Marketing & Events Coordinator. Work continued on the fundraising plan implementation, Art & Wine Festival planning, historic preservation, temporary parking plans and the Heritage Festival. 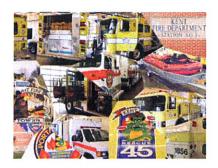
