RE: Position Allocation increase of two (2) additional Seasonal Park

Maintenance Workers (1040 Hours per year) AND

Budget Appropriation Increase (\$23,000)

The City of Kent AFSCME Agreement permits the employment of up to four Seasonal Park Maintenance Workers. I have been working with Gene Roberts on transferring some of the mowing maintenance responsibilities of city property on a trial basis this summer. It is hoped to hire two additional Seasonal Park Maintenance Workers, supplemented by current parks employees to accomplish this task.

We have identified a number of efficiencies that should result in a cost savings as compared to the outside contracts performing these duties in the past. In addition, this should free up Service Worker man hours as they are forced to mow into the shoulder seasons of spring and fall prior to start of the Summer Mowing Contract.

By staggering two Seasonal Park Maintenance Workers supplemented by other park crews at times we are confident we can increase efficiency. The cost to the city of the summer mowing contract should cover the entire mowing seasons of spring, summer and fall. In addition, the man hours expended by full time city Service Workers will be greatly reduced, freeing them up for higher priority projects.

Please place this increase in the allocation ordinance to increase the Seasonal Park Maintenance Worker from two to four. Also, the budget appropriation for Parks & Recreation should also be increased by \$22,000 (\$19,000 Salaries + \$3,000 Fringe Benefits).

Planning for the current project began in 2006 with the Kent State University Area Citizens Advisory Committee. In 2008, the City received approximately \$9.7 million in grant funds from AMATS and ODOT to solve safety and congestion problems along the corridor. The detailed planning and design process began in 2009. With the aid of a citizen's advisory committee, recommended solutions and alternates were determined and presented at two public meetings in late 2011. Staff will update council on the recommended solutions, alternates presented, public input received and the final recommendation to move forward with the detailed design of the project.

Page 2 Board of Zoning Appeals Staff Report April 16, 2012 meeting

ANALYSIS:

This property is located at 325 West Elm Street and is currently zoned R-3: High Density Residential. This home is a single family dwelling that is currently being renovated and used as a meeting house for a non-profit organization. Currently, no one lives at this house.

To use this property as a meeting location, the applicant is asking the Planning Commission for a conditional zoning certificate that will allow them to use the property as a philanthropic institution. This will go before the Commission on April 17, 2012. There are a few conditions that the applicants will not meet, therefore, they are asking for variances.

The first variance pertains to the 100-foot activities and building setback under the first condition in Chapter 1171. There is an existing detached garage on the property that is close to the property line. The applicants have no plans to move the structure; therefore they are requesting the variance to allow the structure to be less than 100 feet from the property line. Also, this property is only 60 feet wide; they would need a variance to have any new structures or activity areas with this condition in place.

The second variance is relief from the requirement to be on a major thoroughfare or at the intersection of a major thoroughfare and a collector street. This property is located on a local street. The applicant explains that they do not have a lot of traffic, as they are at the house twice a month for meetings and to work on the house. Therefore, having the property on a major street is not a necessity for the organization.

ANALYSIS:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Born Free MC Toy Run Inc. is a motorcycle club that has non-profit status and participates in volunteer work to better the community. They purchased the house at 325 West Elm Street and wish to use it as a meeting place. The proposed plan is to convert the single family house to a philanthropic institution. Many repairs have already been made to the house itself and further remodeling is planned. There are no site improvements proposed at this time.

Meetings are scheduled every other Friday at 7 pm and last from 1 - 1 1/2 hours. Afterwards some socialization occurs. There are approximately 15 members. Previously the meetings were held at different member's homes.

Philanthropic institutions are conditionally permitted in the R-3 zoning district and are subject to some other requirements outlined in Sections 1171.01(1), (2), (3), (5), (7), (9), (11), and (17) of the Kent Codified Ordinances as listed below. These conditions have been met except (1) & (7) which is planned to go before the Board of Zoning Appeals on April 16, 2012.

- (1) All structures and activity areas shall be located at least 100 feet from all property lines.
- (2) Loudspeakers which cause a hazard or annoyance shall not be permitted.
- (3) All points of vehicular entrance or exit shall be located no closer than 200 feet from the intersection of two major thoroughfares, or no closer than 100 feet from the intersection of a major thoroughfare and a local or collector thoroughfare.
- (5) No lighting shall constitute a nuisance or in any way impair safe movement of traffic on any street or highway; no lighting shall shine directly on adjacent properties.
- (7) Such developments shall be located on major thoroughfares or at intersections of major and/or collector thoroughfares.
- (9) Such uses shall not require uneconomical extensions of utility services at the expense of the community.
- (11) Such uses shall be properly landscaped to be harmonious with surrounding residential uses.
- (17) All permitted installations shall be maintained in a neat orderly condition so as to prevent injury to any single property, any individual, or to the community in general; a bond may be required to insure that this provision will be met.

TRAFFIC/PARKING:

Ingress and egress is from West Elm Street. There is no specific parking requirement for a philanthropic institution. Where the off-street parking requirement for a use is not specifically defined in Chapter 1167, the parking facilities for such use shall be developed so as to be sufficient to meet all the parking needs of the proposed use. The applicant proposes to use the existing driveway and on-street parking. On street parking is permitted on the north side of West Elm Street. The members also car pool to the meetings. The driveway can accommodate 4 cars.

UTILITIES:

Utility connections are existing.

STORMWATER:

There is no change to the impervious area of the site, hence, no storm water management is required.

SIGNAGE:

No signs are proposed.

LIGHTING/LANDSCAPING/DUMPSTER:

This is an existing site with existing lighting, landscaping and trash can(s).

ARCHITECTURAL ADVISORY BOARD:

The Architectural Review Board is not required to review this project.

VARIANCES:

Two variances from the Board of Zoning Appeals, listed below, still need to be obtained. The applicant plans to appear before the board at the April 16, 2012 meeting.

- 1. All structures and activity areas shall be located at least 100 feet from all property lines.
- 2. Such developments shall be located on major thoroughfares or at intersections of major and/or collector thoroughfares.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff has concerns about the parking, meetings times and potential noise and would like to hear the comments presented in the public hearing before offering a recommendation.

The Planning Commission may approve, approve with conditions, or disapprove the application. Should Planning Commission wish to make a motion for this project the following language may be used:

I move that in Case PC12-003, the Planning Commission approve the Conditional Zoning Certificate and Site Plan to operate a philanthropic institution at 325 West Elm Street subject to the following conditions.

Commissioner's Report

A draft Water Interruption Policy for the City of Kent, was provided in the Health Board packet for discussion and approval.

An application has been submitted for the Ohio Public Health Partnership for our strategic planning project targeted for later this month. Maximum award is \$10,000 but it would also provide staff CQI training and technical assistance throughout our strategic planning process.

Included in the Health Board packet is the monthly Public Health Preparedness Report from Portage County. This report will be included with the packets from this point forward for your information.

Dr. Bartholomew is on vacation for the month of March. Dr. Marcial (Ravenna Medical Director) will temporarily fill in through March 15 and then Dr. Raub (Portage County Medical Director) will cover the remainder of his vacation through April 2nd.

We submitted an application to be granted access to use the Ohio Epicenter. This will help us conduct better surveillance fulfilling Essential Public Health Service #1.

Ravenna will be hiring an interim Health Commissioner and the advertisement was included with the Health Board packet.

The Health Department will be putting up the Pontiac Sunfire for auction as it is not a workable vehicle for everyday use.

Included in the Health Board packet was the update provided to the Portage County Public Health Task Force at last week's meeting.

Jeff attended City Council meeting last week and discussed the need for the City of Kent to adopt the State of Ohio Interior Building Code as was supported and approved by the board of health in January.

Water system fees were included in the Board packet as we will discuss on the agenda.

Jeff stated items that are going to require immediate his attention include the development of a health assessment for houses that are confirmed Methamphetamine homes by the KPD, onsite wastewater system fees, and mosquito control program procedures.

A draft Deputy Health Commissioner job description and sanitarian position description has been provided for discussion.

Old Business

The Portage County Task Force Update— Marchelle Bobbs and Jeff Neistadt attended the last meeting of the Portage County Task Force. Marchelle stated that each Commissioner gave a report on what they were working on. There were discussions of data collection for the Maternal and Child Community health assessment grant. Overall the meeting was very positive.

Health Department Staffing – Jonnette will be leaving the Health Department and Take the Lab Tech job at Laboratory on March 26. So we will have an open Sanitarian position. She will be intermittently assisting us as needed. The Internal Sanitarian posting was put out today, March 13, 2012.

Jeff stated that he is still considering a couple options regarding staffing. He has been questioning the Deputy Health Commissioner position, because he can actually get two people for that one position, possibly a Sanitarian Supervisor and an Environmental Technician that can do trash, mosquito work, as well as Pretreatment and Lab stuff.

Jeff would like a commitment from the board that he may pursue further discussions with Gene Roberts and Bob Brown regarding a shared Environmental Technician

Motion:

A motion was made by Doug Wagener and seconded by Marchelle Bobbs for Jeff to continue discussions with Gene Roberts and Bob Brown for a possible new environmental position. The motion passed.

The guidance document for interruption of water service - This new policy outlines the steps that should be taken when a food service operation will be without potable water. It was reviewed prior to the health board meeting. Chris Woolverton requested one change to the section of "when water service is restored." He asked that a specific flush time be added when flushing pipes, faucets, ice machines, etc.

Motion:

A motion was made by Susan Roxburgh and seconded by Jack Amrhein to approve the Policy for Interruption of Water Service. The motion passed.

Emergency Resolution 2012-001 - Private water and sewer systems Applications and Permit fees – Jeff stated that the fees have not been changed since 1989. A recent question arose from an individual with a private well and looking at the fees they are not in line with the state program. Approving this resolution, would cover our costs.
