ORDINANCE NO. 2020-103

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT EASEMENTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTHWEST SANITARY PUMP STATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent Council desires to obtain certain temporary and permanent easements from property owners for the construction of the Southwest Sanitary Pump Station Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the property owners listed below have agreed to sell the easement interests to the City for the Project in the amounts listed; and

WHEREAS, the City needs the property for right-of-way purposes for the construction of said Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby accepts and authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute the agreements for the City of Kent to obtain temporary and permanent easements for construction of the Southwest Sanitary Pump Station project in substantial conformity with the terms of the Agreement marked as Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein for the following properties:

- a) Stephen W. Ryan, 1224 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (5-T), \$2,940.00; 20' sanitary sewer easement (5-S) for \$562.00 for right-of-way purposes.
- b) Kyle D. Veon and Lauren N. Veon, 1230 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (4-T), \$725.00.
- c) John M. Gonos and Jo Marie Gonos, 636 Yacavona Drive, 10' sanitary sewer easement (14-S) for \$420.00 for right-of-way purposes.
- d) William J. Krul and Lucille C. Krul, 1214 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (7-T), \$1,920.00; 10' sanitary sewer easement (7-S) for \$332.00 for right-of-way purposes.
- e) Bonnie M. Droder, 1208 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (8-T), \$1,650.00; 10' sanitary sewer easement (8-S) for \$332.00 for right-of-way purposes.
- f) Henry Ailes, 1204 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (9-T), \$900.00; 10' sanitary sewer easement (9-S) for \$332.00 for right-of-way purposes.
- g) Jacob R. Fargo, 1178 Middlebury Road, temporary easement (12-T), \$1,310.00.
- h) Patrick C. Madonio, 644 Yacavona Drive, 10' sanitary sewer easement (16-S) for \$362.00 for right-of-way purposes

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage. Temporary Work Agreements and Permanent Sanitary Easements

Engineering is requesting Council time for the approval of payments to four property owners of four parcels needed for the construction of the Southwest Sanitary Pump Station Project. The project is anticipated to start construction in 2021.

Portions of the existing sanitary sewer upstream of the Middlebury Pump Station and Yacavona Pump Station are located on private property. The new sanitary sewer that will be constructed with the Southwest Sanitary Pump Station project will be either located in the City's right-of-way or in a new sanitary sewer easement. In order to tie the existing laterals into the new sanitary sewer, some temporary work agreements are required. There is also a new sanitary sewer easement that will overlay an existing drainage easement along the rear properties of the east of Yacavona. A total of 11 temporary and 11 permanent easements will be required from 16 parcels. Please see attached map.
