





Unauthorized Items

1. CORF Application for Ametek Property (Draft No. 11-126)

Staff is requesting Council's authorization to proceed with the application for Clean Ohio Revitalization Funds (CORF) for the Ametek property as approved with the land sale agreement for the relocation of the Ametek employees into downtown Kent.

Administration Recommendation

As previously discussed with Council, the staff have been working with Ametek over the last year to complete the preliminary site assessment (also using Clean Ohio Funds) for the Ametek property and now with the results in hand we want to apply for the funds available to remediate the site and get it ready for redevelopment.

Council Action

Authorize the staff to submit the CORF application for the Ametek property.

2. Kent Police Donation (Draft 11-125)

1. Board of Zoning Appeals December 19th Meeting

2. Fire Incident Report

Jim Williams has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for November 2011. In 2011 calls for fire service are up 1% (10 calls); fire mutual aid assistance is up by 1 event in 2011; and EMS responses are up 1% (49 calls). (attachment)

3. Vacant and Abandoned Buildings Update

For your information, Jim Silver has provided a revised copy of the vacant/abandoned building ordinance that Council changed on the floor on November 16, 2011. The change added a sentence noting that a house must be vacant for 1 year prior to registration being required. (attachment)

4. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Lee has provided a copy of the police statistics report for November 2011. In 2011 calls for service are down 6% (1,278 calls); traffic citations are down 15% (455 tickets); accident incidents are up 4% (30 incidents) and serious crimes are up 1% (13 cases). (attachment)
