1. NOPEC Foundation Grant Submission (Draft #2023-038)

Bridget has asked for Council's authorization to submit a sustainability grant funding request to NOPEC in the amount up to \$40,000 for a feasibility study to gauge the local interest in energy efficiency usage in City residential and commercial properties in Kent. (attachment)

Administration Recommendation
