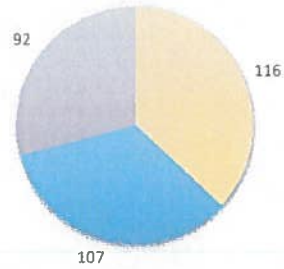
Traffic Stop by Shift



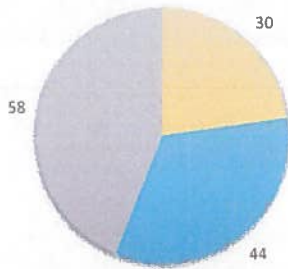
