Unauthorized Items

1. Accept \$50 Donation to the Kent Fire Department (Draft #2021-029)

Chief Tosko is requesting Council's authorization to accept a \$50 donation from John and Nancy Thomas to the Kent Fire Department in honor and memory of former Kent Fire Chief Bud Rhoads. (attachment)

Administration Recommendation

Council Action

Authorize the acceptance and allocation of the \$50 donation with the Emergency Clause.

2. Accept Office Donations to the Kent Health Department (Draft #2021-030)

3. Amend City Property Right of Access Agreement (Draft #2021-031)

Bridget is requesting Council's authorization to amend the access agreement approved in 2019 for the remediation of the property at 800 Mogadore Road (former RB&W site) on the backside of Kramer Ball Fields. The access agreement amendment expands the work area in order to properly safeguard the river from contaminants. (attachment)

Council Action

Authorize the proposed amendments to the access agreement with the Emergency Clause.

1. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Tosko has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for January 2021. In 2021 calls for fire service are down 2% (5 calls); fire mutual aid assistance is unchanged with 1 call as compared to 2020; and EMS responses are up 7% (19 calls). (attachment)
