


Administration Recommendation

1. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Lee has provided a copy of the police statistics report for September 2017. In 2017 calls for service are down 9% (1,893 calls); traffic citations are down 17% (481 tickets); accident incidents are down 29% (219 incidents) and serious crimes are down 10% (55 cases). (attachment)
