RESOLUTION NO. 2021 -113

A RESOLUTION ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF ACTIVE, INTERIM, AND INACTIVE DEPOSITS TO BE AWARDED, FIXING PERIOD OF DESIGNATION AND DATE OF AWARDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 135 mandates that depositories must be designated every five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Kent City Council wishes to proceed with the designation of depositories for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. That the aggregate amount of public funds to be awarded for deposit during the period from December 17, 2021 to December 16, 2026 are as follows:

Active Deposits	\$20 Million
Interim Deposits	\$35 Million
Inactive Deposits	

SECTION 2. That the period for which said active, interim, and inactive deposits will be awarded shall be for the period from December 17, 2021 to December 16, 2026, both dates inclusive.

SECTION 3. That this Council shall meet on the 17th day of November, 2021 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of designating the depository or depositories of said funds.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk of this Council shall cause notice of the adoption of this Resolution to be published once a week for two consecutive weeks.

SECTION 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective in order to eliminate existing hazards to vehicular traffic; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the City Manager, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the Council, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
