AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2022-137 THE POSITION ALLOCATION AND GENERAL COMPENSATION PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Council does hereby approve an amendment to the 2023 Position Allocation Ordinance, 2022-137 to update the, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That all existing ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.

Exhibit A

SECTION 3.2. The following employee positions shall be paid for professional services rendered at the rate of thirty dollars and thirty-six cents (\$30.36) per hour established below:

Intermittent/On-Call Inspector; Building Inspector (including Electrical & Plumbing)

- 1. The amount of thirty dollars and thirty-six cents (\$30.36) shall not be paid in less than one (1) hour increments. for each residential dwelling unit(s), commercial structure, or industrial facility inspected on any one day.
- 2. The amount of thirty dollars and thirty-six cents (\$30.36) per hour of attendance at meetings, when such attendance is required by the City.
- 3. The Intermittent Inspector shall be paid for one inspection if there are multiple units at one location.
- 4. Payment shall be made on a monthly basis in accordance with the City's regular pay schedule. Payment shall be based on the approved monthly service report submitted by the employee, which shall serve as the employee's invoice for payment. These payment items are not subject to the merit salary adjustment (Article 20, Section 5).

SECTION 3.3. The following employee positions shall be paid for professional services rendered at the rate of forty dollars and eighty-five cents (\$40.85) per hour.

Intermittent / On-Call Plans Examiner
Intermittent / On-Call Alternate Building Official / Alternate Plans Examiner

Said positions, listed in Sections 3.2-and 3.3, shall not be subject to the merit salary adjustment (Article 20, Section 5) or the Annual Salary Adjustment (Article 20, Sections 2 & 4).

Position Allocation

Add 1 temporary full-time position in the Fire Department titled, "Interim Fire Chief" and place that position in Pay Classification I. The Interim Fire Chief will be entitled to all the benefits and terms of the General Compensation Plan as the Fire Chief position. This temporary position will expire and be removed from the Position Allocation 180 days from the passage of this legislation.
