ORDINANCE NO. 2020-98

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF A PARCEL OF CITY OWNED LAND KNOWN AS A "PAPER" STREET AND KNOWN AS WHITEWOOD DRIVE OFF OF ADRIAN AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Kent City Council wishes to vacate a parcel of City owned land known as a "paper" street, and known as Whitewood Drive off of Adrian Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 723.04, the City Council of the City of Kent will be receiving a Petition attached hereto as Exhibit "A" from the adjoining property owners to vacate the "paper" street known as Whitewood Drive off of Adrian Avenue; and

WHEREAS, if the property is vacated, the adjacent property owners would get possession of the land to the center of the paper road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the "paper" street known as Whitewood Drive off of Adrian Avenue be vacated upon receipt by the City Clerk of Council of a properly executed petition for said vacation; a copy of said agreement is marked as Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That a vacation plat, together with a certified copy of this Ordinance and a survey, if necessary, shall be delivered by the City Engineer to the Portage County Recorder, upon receipt of the petition.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
