



## **Unauthorized Items**

1. Parks and Recreation Donation (2022-104)

Angela has requested Council's authorization to accept a \$5,000 donation to Kent Parks and Recreation from the Adam Hamilton Memorial Academic & Athletic Scholarship Fund to support youth football and cheer programs. (attachment)



I recommend Council accept and allocate the \$5,000 donation to Kent Parks and Recreation.

#### Council Action

Authorize the acceptance and allocation of the \$5,000 donation to Kent Parks and Recreation from the Adam Hamilton Memorial Fund, with the Emergency Clause.

### 2. Temporary Road Closure for KSU Homecoming Event Downtown

Dana with KSU, Marilyn Sessions, and Michelle Hartman are planning a downtown Homecoming event for Friday night, September 30<sup>th</sup>, on the Hometown Bank Plaza. For safety reasons they asked if the City would temporarily close Main Street (adjacent to the Plaza) from 7-9 pm.

#### Administration Recommendation

I recommend Council authorize the 2 hour street closure in support of the participants' safety in the downtown Homecoming event.

### Council Action

Authorize the 2 hour street closure of Main Street on September 30<sup>th</sup> from 7 to 9 pm as requested by KSU, the Chamber, and Hometown Bank. \*this item will be on the City Manager's list of unauthorized items that Council votes on with a voice vote – an official resolution or Ordinance is not needed.

### 1. Income Tax Report

Rhonda Hall has provided a summary of income tax collections for the August of 2022. Overall the City income tax collections YTD are up 10.6% (\$1,048,574) compared with August of 2021. For the month of August the City income tax collections are up 3.6% (\$39,565) compared to August 2021. (attachment)
