



## Unauthorized Items

### 1. Accept a \$180 Donation to Parks and Recreation

Angela is requesting Council's authorization to accept a \$180 donation to Kent Parks and Recreation from the Kent Jaycees to support the Teen Scavenger Hunt. (attachment)

#### *Administration Recommendation*

I recommend Council's authorization to accept and allocate the \$180 donation.

#### *Council Action*

**Authorize the acceptance and allocation of the \$180 donation from the Kent Jaycees.**

### 2. Authorize a CMAQ Grant Submission for the SR59 Alternative Transportation Project (draft #2023-046)

Jim is requesting Council's authorization to submit a Congestion, Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant funding request in the amount of \$3,112,000 to be used on the joint City/Township/PARTA SR59 Transportation Improvement Project (construction limits from Horning Road east to SR261). #### *Administration Recommendation*

The City's share of the funding is in the approved 2023-2027 Capital Improvement Plan and I recommend Council authorize the CMAQ grant funding request, and if approved, authorize acceptance and allocation of the grant funds.

#### *Council Action*

**Authorize the submission of the CMAQ grant funding request in the amount of \$3,112,000, and if approved, authorize acceptance and allocation of the grant funds, with the emergency clause.**

### 3. Proposed Amendment to the General Compensation Plan and Position Allocation Ordinance (draft #2023-047)

Rhonda has requested Council's consideration of proposed changes to the City's General Compensation Plan and Allocation Ordinance. The proposed changes will be discussed in the Executive Session.

#### *Administration Recommendation*

The proposed changes relate to the payment of the City's part time building inspectors and I recommend Council approve the changes as presented in the Executive Session.

#### *Council Action*

## Information Items

### 1. Monthly Permit and Zoning Reports

Bridget Susel has enclosed copies of the monthly zoning and permit violations report for June 2023. Permit revenues were \$10,167.42 for June with the most permits being issued for residential HVAC (30 permits). There were 15 code enforcement items for the month. (attachment)

### 2. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Shearer has provided a copy of the police statistics report for May 2023. In 2023, calls for service are down 17.5% for the month (by 373 calls); traffic citations are down 46.8% (109 tickets); accident incidents are up by one incident at 51 incidents for the month and serious crimes are down by one from 2 to 1 incident, compared to May of 2022.
