Administration Recommendation

Council has reviewed the proposed project funding allocations in Committee and held public hearings to receive public comment to the plan. Staff was informed by HUD that the City's 2018 CDBG funding allocation will be \$29,000 more than 2017 and that additional funding will be used to fund a required update to the City's Fair Housing analysis and restore previous admin funding cuts. I recommend Council's approval.
