







Work Session

The City Clerk has scheduled a Work Session beginning at 6:30 pm for Council to receive an update on the status of the new City Hall design.

Unauthorized Items

1. Accept a Donation for Parks and Recreation (Draft #2019-67)

John Idone is requesting Council's authorization to accept a series of individual donations totaling \$5,700 to Kent Parks and Recreation in support of the Torch Fest planned for June 20th. (attachment)

Council Action

Authorize the acceptance of the donations totaling \$5,700 to Kent Parks and Recreation.

2. Accept a Donation for the Kent Police Department (Draft #2019-68)

Chief Lee is requesting Council's authorization to accept a donation of 30 pairs of specialized Police eyeware produced by AlphaMicron to support officer safety. Each pair of glasses is valued at \$212 so the donation value is \$6,360. (attachment)

Council Action

<u>Information Items</u>

1. Fire Incident Report

Chief Tosko has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services report for March 2019. In 2019 calls for fire service are up 19% (48 calls); fire mutual aid assistance is down 4 events as compared to 2018; and EMS responses are up 6% (57 calls). (attachment)

2. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Lee has provided a copy of the police statistics report for April 2019. In 2019 calls for service are up 19% (1,865 calls); traffic citations are up 15% (164 tickets); accident incidents are down 1% (3 incidents) and serious crimes are up 7.5% (14 cases). (attachment)

3. Monthly Permit and Zoning Reports

Bridget Susel has enclosed copies of the monthly zoning and permit violations report for May 2019. Permit revenues were \$11,624.29 for May with the most permits being issued for Electrical Commercial (72 permits). There were 57 code enforcement items in May. (attachment)
